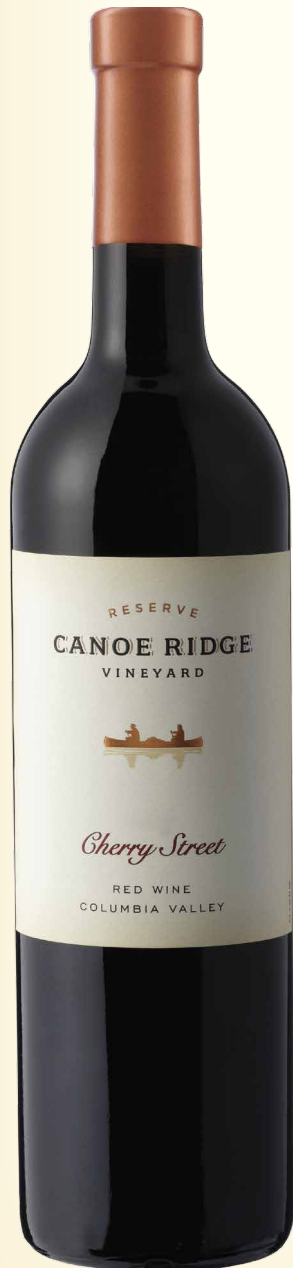

TASTING NOTE

This fruit-forward, full-bodied blend offers aromas and flavors of cassis, blackberry, plum and a hint of cedar on the lingering finish. Pair with grilled burgers, pan-seared steaks and tomato-sauced dishes.

ABOUT THE VINEYARDS

The majority of this blend is sourced from the Horse Heaven Hills AVA. This hot, arid region gets winds that sweep up to ridge-perched vineyards from the nearby Columbia River. Winds and the insulating effect of the nearby river contribute to healthy vines and wines with well-supported tannins. Canoe Ridge Vineyard is best known for its Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, and Wallula, also known as “The Benches” for its stunning, stepped scenery and versatility.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The warmest vintage in a decade, 2013's growing season cooled off just in time for harvest, and picking proceeded at a normal pace starting at the end of August. Total tonnage, approximately 220,000 tons, was up easily five percent over 2012, a record for Washington State. With a warm 2013 vintage, growers spread out canopies a bit more than usual and adjusted crop sizes to achieve a good balance of acidity and phenolic ripeness. Mother Nature made picking advantageous; varieties reached ripeness at different times, allowing crews a well-phased, thoughtfully-planned harvest.
